We welcome the submission of abstracts for **talks and posters** on any recent research related to sensitivity. **Submission deadline: 21st February 2026**

Submission Guidelines

You may submit abstracts for **talks or posters**:

- **Talks:** 10-minute presentation followed by 5 minutes of Q&A
- **Posters:** Interactive poster session in the afternoon

Please indicate in your submission whether the abstract is intended for a **talk or a poster**. If you submit an abstract for a talk, please also indicate whether you would be happy for your abstract to be **considered for presentation as a poster** in case it will not be selected for a talk (the number of talk slots is limited).

Abstract Requirements (Talks and Posters)

- **Length:** Maximum 300 words
- **Structure:**
 - **Title:** Concise and informative (maximum 10 words)
 - **Authors:** List all authors and their affiliations
 - **Presenting author:** Indicate the presenting author
 - **Background:** Provide the context of your research
 - **Methods:** Briefly describe the methodologies used
 - **Results:** Summarise the main findings
 - **Conclusion:** Highlight the implications and significance of your results



Key Information

- All abstracts will undergo **peer review** by the scientific committee, based on originality, relevance, and scientific rigour.
- Only **empirical research** will be considered, with priority given to **new and unpublished findings** (or findings published recently, from May 2025 onwards).
- Only **in-person presentations** can be considered (no remote presentations).
- Authors of accepted abstracts must **register for the conference** to present their work.

Authors will be informed of the outcome of the peer-review process by **mid of March 2026**.
